STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 45th Avenue Northeast, hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilites serving the area and have been advised that an easement was granted to the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District.
- 3. The Division of the building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of the public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
