ORDINANCE NO. 7519

AN ORDINANCE approving Amendments to the
Water District 82 Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On August 11, 1980, the King County Council approved Ordinance 5045, approving the Water District 124 Comprehensive Water Plan.

On July 15, 1985, Water District 82 adopted Resolution No. A630, Amendments to the Comprehensive Water Plan.

On May 31, 1985, Water District 124 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for these Amendments.

On September 3, 1985, the Comprehensive Plan Amendments were reviewed by the Utilities Technical Review Committee as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. The Committee recommended conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Resolution No. A630 of Water District 82, is hereby approved

Provided that:

No water service is provided to the Rural Areas within the amendment, unless the criteria in the East Sammamish Community Plan allowing Class I water service are met.
