ORDINANCE NO. 7557

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as No. P-298 to Cascade Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as No. P-298 to Cascade Sewer District was filed with the county council effective January 9, 1986.

2. Cascade Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 2309 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Cascade Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated December 9, 1985, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 7th day of April, 1986 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Cascade Sewer District of the area known as No. P-298 and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 56.02.060 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on No. P-298.

SECTION 2. The Cascade Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area, nor does it authorize sewer service in any area not designated as a "Local Service Area" by the King County Sewerage General Plan.

1        SECTION 4. The area known as No. P-298 to be annexed is  
2 described as follows:

3        Beginning at the West quarter corner of Section 30, Township  
4 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, said  
5 point being on the existing boundary of Cascade Sewer District.

6        Thence East along the East-West Centerline of said Section 30  
7 to the East line of the West half of the West half of the West  
8 half of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter thereof;

9        Thence South along said East line to the North line of the  
10 Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 30;

11       Thence West along said North line to the Northwest corner of  
12 said Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter;

13       Thence South along the West line of said Southeast quarter of  
14 the Southwest quarter to the South line of said Section 30  
15 also being the North line of Section 31, Township 22 North,  
16 Range 6 East, W.M.

17       Thence West along the North line of said Section 31 to the  
18 East line of the West 792.00 feet of Government Lot 1 in the  
19 Northwest quarter thereof;

20       Thence South along the East line of said West 792.00 feet to  
21 the South line of the Burlington Northern Railroad  
22 Right-of-Way;

23       Thence easterly along the south line of said railroad  
24 right-of-way to the East line of the Northwest quarter of said  
25 Section 31;

26       Thence South along said East line to the Northwesterly line of  
27 the Plat of Winterwood Estates Division No. 6 as recorded in  
28 Volume 123 of Plats, pages 58 through 62 inclusive, records of  
29 King County, Washington;

30       Thence Southwesterly and Southerly along the Northwesterly and  
31 Westerly margin of said Plat of Winterwood Division No. 6 and  
32 Southerly and Westerly along the Westerly and Northerly margin  
33 of the Plat of Winterwood Estates Division No. 1 as recorded  
in Volume 100 of Plats, pages 17 and 18, records of King  
County, Washington, to the West line of said Section 31;

1 Thence North along said West line and along the West line of  
2 Section 30, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M., to the  
Point of Beginning.
