ORDINANCE NO. 7589

An Ordinance establishing a Water Utility
Coordinating Committee for the South
King County Critical Water Supply Area.

PREAMBLE:

On December 16, 1985 the King County council passed
Motion 6407 adopting the Preliminary Assessment of Water
Supply and Fire Protection Issues in King County, and
pursuant to RCW 70.116 designating South King County a
Critical Water Supply Area.

RCW 70.116 requires a Utility Coordinating Committee to
establish the boundaries of the Critical Water Supply
Area and to prepare a Coordinated Water System Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A water utility coordinating committee for
the South King County Critical Water Supply Area is established
for the purpose of implementing the Public Water System
Coordination Act of 1977.

SECTION 2. The committee shall consist of representatives
from the following agencies:

- A. The King County council
- B. Planning and community development department
- C. The Seattle-King County health department
- D. The Department of Social and Health Services.
- E. King County Water District 54
- F. King County Water District 56
- G. King County Water District 75
- H. King County Water District 94
- I. King County Water District 105
- J. King County Water District 111
- K. City of Algona
- L. City of Auburn
- M. Auburn East Mobile Home Park
- N. Auburn Mobile Park
- O. City of Black Diamond
- P. Crestview West Water System

- 1 Q. Cherokee Bay Water System
2 R. Cristalina Water System
3 S. City of Enumclaw
4 T. Easthill Community Well Company
5 U. Federal Way Water and Sewer District
6 V. Forest Grove Hills Water System
7 W. City of Kent
8 X. Masonic Home of Washington Water System
9 Y. City of Milton
10 Z. City of Pacific

15 And all other purveyors with fifty or more service connections.
16 Each of the listed agencies shall appoint a member and an
17 alternate to the committee. Appointed members shall continue
18 to serve until replaced by the appointing authority in
19 accordance with the by-laws of the committee.

20 SECTION 3. A. In order for the committee to conduct
21 business, a quorum consisting of not less than half of the
22 appointed members shall be present.

23 B. At the first meeting of the committee, a chairperson
24 and rules for conducting business shall be determined by
25 consensus.

26 C. Within six months of its establishment, the committee
27 shall be responsible for developing and recommending external
28 critical water area boundaries to the county council in the
29 manner prescribed in WAC 248-56-600.

30 D. Following the establishment of the external bounda-
31 ries, the committee shall be responsible for developing a
32 coordinated water system plan for the critical water supply

1 service area in accordance with the procedures provided in
2 WAC 248-56-740. On completion of the plan, the committee shall
3 submit the plan to the Washington State Department of Social
4 and Health Services via King County which shall conduct the
5 local review required by law. The plan shall be submitted
6 within eighteen months of the establishment of the committee.

7 E. The coordinated water system plan and external
8 critical water service area boundaries shall be reviewed and
9 updated as appropriate by the committee at a minimum of every
10 five years, or sooner if the committee deems it necessary, as
11 prescribed in WAC 248-56-760.

12 SECTION 4. The water utility coordinating committee shall
13 be terminated effective June 30th, 1992 unless specifically
14 extended by ordinance.
