ORDINANCE NO. 7620

AN ORDINANCE related to the King County Park System; making obstruction of Trails a misdemeanor; adding a new section to the King County Code; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is added to Ordinance 6798 and K.C.C. 7.12, Part IV - Rules Governing Use of Facilities - Misdemeanors, a new section to read as follows:

Interference with Trails. It shall be unlawful for any person to place, deposit, or otherwise cause or suffer to be located any structure, device, or natural or artificial thing that threatens or endangers any portion of a Trail owned or maintained by King County, or that tends to endanger persons traveling thereon, or obstructs or tends to obstruct or constitutes a hazard to persons traveling thereon.

This section shall not apply to employees of King County in the performance of their duties or to persons acting pursuant to written direction of King County.
