ORDINANCE NO: 7621

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Standardized Salary Schedule and the annual cost-of-living increase for King County employees as stipulated in K.C.C. 3.12.130 and K.C.C. 3.12.140.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The attached King County Standardized Salary Schedule, entitled "Schedule of Pay Ranges and Steps in Annual, Monthly, and Semi-Monthly Amounts and Hourly Rates," is approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Employees of the King County District Courts, King County Superior Court, and the King County Council, shall have their salaries increased by 2.00% effective January 1, 1986. This increase shall not apply to elected officials, Superior Court Commissioners, or those employees who are in a collective bargaining unit.

SECTION 3. Non-represented employees of the King County prosecuting attorney's office shall be eligible to receive a cost-of-living adjustment determined by the prosecuting attorney, effective January 1, 1986. The amount to be applied shall be determined by increasing the aggregate salary base in effect prior to the effective date by an amount of 2.00%.

SECTION 4. Employees of the executive branch, non-elected employees of the department of assessments, and employees of the alcoholism and substance abuse, emergency medical services and medical examiner divisions of the Seattle-King County department of public health; except employees included in collective bargaining units and employees holding the rank of Captain and Major in the department of public safety, those holding the rank of Lieutenant in the department of adult detention, those

1 defined as first level supervisors in the department of public
2 works, and the airport security chief shall have their salaries
3 increased by 2.00% effective January 1, 1986. Captains and
4 Majors in the department of public safety shall have their
5 salaries increased by the percentage increase accorded
6 Lieutenants in the Police Bargaining Unit for 1986. Lieutenants
7 in the department of adult detention shall have their salaries
8 increased the percentage increase accorded the Correction
9 Sergeants in the Corrections Officer bargaining unit for 1986.
10 Assistant supervisors in the public works department shall have
11 their salaries increased by an amount equivalent to that provided
12 to equipment operator II positions covered by the Construction
13 Crafts collective bargaining agreement. The airport security
14 chief salary increase shall be that required to maintain a 7.5%
15 differential above the 1986 airport security officer II
16 annualized wage rate.

17 SECTION 5. Effective January 1, 1986, and annually
18 thereafter, the elected office of the prosecuting attorney shall
19 be compensated at an annual rate of 86.2 percent of the
20 authorized annual compensation of the King County executive as it
21 may be adjusted from time to time.

22 SECTION 6. Effective January 1, 1986, and annually
23 thereafter, the elected office of the King County assessor shall
24 be compensated at an annual rate of 78.5 percent of the
25 authorized annual compensation of the King County executive as it
26 may be adjusted from time to time.

27 SECTION 7. Should any section, subsection, paragraph,
28 sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be declared
