ORDINANCE NO. 7633

AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Building Code; adopting the 1986 Washington State Energy Code; amending Ordinance 3647, Section 6; as amended; and repealing Ordinance 4753, Section 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9, the King County Energy Code; and adding a new section to King County Code 16.04.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3647, Section 6; as amended, and King County Code Section 16.04.050 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

Supplements adopted. The 1986 Washington State Energy Code ((King County Energy Code)) and the King County supplements to the adopted 1982 editions of the Uniform Building Code, Uniform Mechanical Code, Uniform Housing Code, Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, and Uniform Fire Code are adopted as part of the code. These codes and supplements constitute county regulation for any activity subject to the code.

SECTION 2. King County Ordinance 4753, Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 are each hereby repealed.

NEW SECTION SECTION 3. As permitted by the Washington State Energy Code Section 302, those areas in King County with Heating Degree Days over 6000 per year shall meet the requirements for Climatic Zone II. The Building Official may enforce such Zone boundaries by Heating Degree Day data or by determination of an average elevation above which will be considered Zone II.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. The effective date of this ordinance shall be April 1, 1986.
