

ORDINANCE NO. 7659

AN ORDINANCE extending the deadline of the temporary moratorium on the issuance, for radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances on Cougar Mountain, of building permits for facilities accessory to a permitted public utility facility and conditional use permits and amending Ordinance 7212, Sections 1 and 3. and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 7212, Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Findings. The King County council finds that:

A. The location of radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances grouped on Cougar Mountain to form an antenna farm are a public health concern to the residents of Cougar Mountain.

B. The department of planning and community development has begun a study of regulations governing the location of radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances with proposed revised regulations due for council consideration in ((4986)) 1986 or 1987.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 7212, Section 3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Duration. The temporary moratorium shall be in effect until the King County council adopts revised regulations for radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances of ((June-30,-4986)) June 30, 1987 whichever occurs first.

SECTION 3. The department of planning and community development shall transmit a preliminary report on the study of regulations for radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances to the King County council by August 1, 1986.

SECTION 4. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or
