ORDINANCE 7748

AN ORDINANCE establishing miscellaneous fees charged by the solid waste division; including a fee for solid waste transported to Cedar Hills by the Seattle Solid Waste Utility, and identifying a per ton charge to be reserved for the energy/resource recovery program; amending Ordinance No. 7012, Section 2 and K.C.C. 10.12.010; amending Ordinance No. 7012, Section 3 and K.C.C. 10.12.020; amending Ordinance No. 6177, Section 4 and K.C.C. 10.12.025; amending Ordinance No. 7012, Section 5 and K.C.C. 10.12.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect on December 1, 1986.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 7012, Section 2, and K.C.C. 10.12.010 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Definitions. For the purposes of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply in the interpretation and enforcement of this chapter:

A. (~~("Commercial-user")~~) "Certificated hauler" means any person engaged in the business of solid waste handling having a certificate granted by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for that purpose.

B. "Compacted waste" means any solid waste whose volume is less than in the loose condition as a result of containment in a closed volume under pressure.

C. "Disposal site" means a land site where or facility at which permanently discarded solid waste is handled, including, but not limited to, landfills, incinerators, and transfer stations.

D. "Noncommercial user" means any person not engaged in the business of solid waste handling.

1 E. "Person" means individual, firm, association,
2 partnership, political subdivision, government agency,
3 municipality, industry, public or private corporation, or any
4 other entity whatsoever.

5 F. "Solid waste" means all putrescible and nonputrescible
6 solid and semisolid materials discarded as a result of any
7 industrial, commercial or agricultural operations and from
8 community or residential activities. It does not include solids
9 nor dissolved material in domestic sewage nor other pollutants in
10 water resources.

11 G. "Manager" means the manager of the solid waste division,
12 King County department of public works, or his designated
13 representative.

14 H. "Uncompacted waste" means any solid waste in a loose
15 condition.

16 I. "Regional direct" means any solid waste transported to
17 Cedar Hills disposal site by conventional long haul transfer
18 vehicles, transporting solid waste generated and collected in
19 King County from solid waste transfer stations.

20 J. "Transfer station" means a staffed, fixed, supplemental
21 collection and transportation facility, used by persons and route
22 collection vehicles to deposit collected solid waste from
23 off-site into a larger transfer vehicle for transport to a
24 permanent disposal site.

25 Section 3. Ordinance No. 7012, Section 3 and K.C.C.
26 10.12.020 are hereby amended to read as follows:

27 Fees for use of disposal sites. All persons using
28 county-operated solid waste disposal facilities shall pay the
29 service fees set forth in the following schedule to become
30 effective ((~~January 1, 1983~~)) December 1, 1986.

31 A. Service fees for the use of disposal sites with scales,
32 excluding Cedar Hills, shall be:

1 Passenger licensed vehicles . ((~~\$-3.50~~)) \$ 6.50 per entry
 2 Other vehicles ((~~\$26.50~~)) \$47.00 per ton
 3 Minimum charge ((~~\$-3.50~~)) \$ 6.50 per vehicle

4 B. Service fees for the use of disposal sites without scales
 5 shall be based upon the cubic yard or fraction thereof as follows:

6 Passenger licensed vehicles . ((~~\$-3.50~~)) \$ 6.50 per entry
 7 Other vehicles
 8 Compacted wastes ((~~\$-7.90~~)) \$14.00 per cubic yard
 9 Uncompacted wastes ((~~\$-4.40~~)) \$ 8.00 per cubic yard
 10 Minimum charge ((~~\$-3.50~~)) \$ 6.50 per vehicle

11 C. Service fees (~~((for-regional-direct-landfill-users-that~~
 12 ~~utilize-conventional-long-haul-transfer-vehicles))~~) at the Cedar
 13 Hills Landfill shall be:

14 Cedar Hills regional direct . ((~~\$11.00~~)) \$31.50 per ton
 15 Other Vehicles \$47.00 per ton

16 Disposal by other vehicles is at the discretion of the solid
 17 waste manager. Any certificated hauler who has been disposing
 18 solid waste at a rural landfill may be authorized by the solid
 19 waste manager to dispose solid waste at the Cedar Hills Regional
 20 Landfill on a temporary, emergency basis at the regional direct
 21 fee.

22 D. In the absence of exact weights or measurements, the
 23 estimate of the manager shall be binding upon the user.

24 SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 6177, Section 4, and K.C.C.

25 10.12.025 are hereby amended to read as follows:

26 Replacement and/or Reclamation of Landfills. Included in the
 27 rate structure listed in K.C.C. 10.12.020 of this chapter is a
 28 ((~~\$1.50~~)) \$3.00 per ton charge that shall be collected for each
 29 ton of solid waste collected in the King County solid waste
 30 system which shall be reserved to provide for the replacement
 31 and/or reclamation of King County operated landfills.

1 SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 7012, Section 5 and K.C.C.
2 10.12.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

3 Special service fees for use of disposal sites. All
4 non-county residents using county-operated solid waste disposal
5 facilities shall pay the service fees set forth in the following
6 schedule:

7 A. Service fees for the use of disposal site with scales
8 shall be:

- 9 Passenger licensed vehicles . ((~~\$-5.50~~)) \$ 8.50 per entry
- 10 Other vehicles ((~~\$35.00~~)) \$55.50 per ton
- 11 Minimum charge ((~~\$-5.00~~)) \$ 8.50 per vehicle

12 B. Special service fees for the use of disposal sites
13 without scales shall be based upon the cubic yard or fraction
14 thereof as follows:

- 15 Passenger licensed vehicles . ((~~\$-5.50~~)) \$ 8.50 per entry
- 16 Other vehicles
- 17 Compacted wastes ((~~\$10.40~~)) \$16.50 per cubic yard
- 18 Uncompacted wastes ((~~\$-5.80~~)) \$ 9.50 per cubic yard
- 19 Minimum charge ((~~\$-5.50~~)) \$ 8.50 per vehicle

20 C. Service fees for regional direct landfill users that
21 utilize conventional long haul transfer vehicles shall be:

- 22 Cedar Hills regional direct . ((~~\$14.00~~)) \$34.50 per ton

23 D. In the absence of exact weights or measurements, the
24 estimate of the manager shall be binding upon the user.

1 NEW SECTION. SECTION 6. Energy/Resource Recovery. Included
2 in the rate structures listed in Sections Three and Five of this
3 ordinance is a \$8.50 per ton charge that shall be collected for
4 each ton of solid waste collected in the King County solid waste
5 system which shall be reserved to provide for the energy/resource
6 recovery program. These funds may only be used as specified by
7 the energy/resource recovery implementation ordinance.
