ORDINANCE NO. 17861

AN ORDINANCE relating to animal control fees and penalties, amending Ordinance 7416, Section 2, Ordinance 1396, Article III, Section 11, and K.C.C. 11.04.035, and K.C.C.11.04.280.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 7416, Section 2 and K.C.C. 11.04.035 are hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Fees. The following fees are applicable to the registration and licensing of dogs and cats kept and maintained in King County as provided in this chapter:

- 1. Dogs - annual.....(~~(\$20.00)~~) \$22.00
- 2. Dogs - annual - with proof that animal has been neutered or spayed.....(~~(\$8.00)~~) \$10.00
- 3. Cats - annual.....\$12.00
- 4. Cats - annual - with proof that animal has been neutered or spayed..... \$7.00
- 5. Special permanent animal license - senior citizens:
 - a. Dogs - with proof that animal has been neutered or spayed.....\$20.00
 - b. Cats - with proof that animal has been neutered or spayed.....\$12.00

B. Penalties. The following penalties are applicable in cases of late registration and licensing of dogs and cats kept and maintained in King County as provided in this chapter:

- 1. New license applications.....\$50.00
- 2. License renewal application:
 - a. Received after thirty days of license expiration but before sixty days.....(~~(\$20.00)~~) \$10.00
 - b. Received after sixty days of license expiration but before ninety days.....(~~(\$40.00)~~) \$20.00
 - c. Received after ninety days of license expiration.....(~~(\$80.00)~~) \$40.00

1 SECTION 2. Ordinance 1396, Article III, Section 11 and K.C.C.
2 11.04.280 are hereby amended to read as follows:

3 Redemption procedures. A. Any animal impounded pursuant to
4 the provisions of section 11.04.210 may be redeemed upon payment
5 of the fee as provided herein. The redemption fee for dogs and
6 cats shall be (~~twenty~~) twenty-five dollars for each such dog or
7 cat (~~(,)~~) on the first offense, forty dollars on the second
8 offense, within one year of the first offense, and fifty-five
9 dollars on the third offense, within one year of the first
10 offense. Owners of impounded licensed dogs or cats shall not be
11 charged a redemption fee on the first offense, but shall be
12 charged on the second offense at the second offense rate.
13 (~~plus an~~) An additional fee of five dollars for each twenty-
14 four hour period, or portion thereof, during which such dog or
15 cat is retained by the impounding agency (~~and~~) shall be made
16 payable to the county comptroller. The redemption fee for
17 livestock shall be fifty dollars per animal impound incident plus
18 any hauling and boarding costs due. Livestock not redeemed may be
19 sold at public auction by the impounding agency. The hauling and
20 boarding costs for livestock impounded shall be in accordance with
21 the rate established by contract between the county and the given
22 stock yard used for holding such animal.
