ORDINANCE NO. 7891

AN ORDINANCE relating to the disposal of
solid waste at King County facilities
amending and correcting Ordinance 7708 and
K.C.C. 10.08.050 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 7708, Section 1 and K.C.C. 10.08.050 is
hereby amended to read as follows:

Use of county disposal sites. A. Interlocal operations.

1. Solid waste disposal sites owned or operated by the
county shall be available to accept solid wastes generated and
collected in municipal corporations situated within the county
which have been using county disposal sites as of April 1, 1986,
provided an interlocal agreement with any such jurisdiction is
executed pursuant to K.C.C. 10.08.130.

2. Any jurisdiction or any commercial hauler not using a
county disposal site as of April 1, 1986, shall be required to
enter into an agreement with King County subject to King County
council approval prior to commencing use of any county disposal
site.

B. Individuals. Any individual may use King County disposal
facilities designated for individual use, in compliance with any
applicable rules and regulations.

C. Dangerous and hazardous waste. Under no circumstances
shall any person deliver to (~~Gedare-Hills~~) any King County Solid
Waste Disposal Facility for disposal any waste that is defined as
"hazardous waste" per the Federal Resource Conservation and
Recovery Act or rules or regulations thereunder, or defined as
"extremely hazardous wastes" or "dangerous wastes" per Chapter
70.105 RCW or rules or regulations thereunder.

1 D. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, no
2 municipal corporation or agent thereof or any commercial hauler
3 shall deposit in any King County solid waste disposal facility
4 solid waste generated within the boundaries of a city which was
5 not using King County solid waste disposal facilities before April
6 1, 1986 and which has not entered into a written use agreement
7 with King County.

8 SECTION 2. The county council finds as a fact and declares
9 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for
10 the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or
11 for the support of county government and its existing public
12 institutions.
