ORDINANCE NO. 7907

1 AN ORDINANCE granting the appeal of the Zoning
2 and Subdivision Examiner's recommendation upon
3 the application for reclassification petitioned
4 by A & F INVESTMENTS, designated File No. 226-86-R,
5 and reclassifying the subject property RM-900-P,
6 subject to conditions.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 This ordinance does hereby reverse the recommendation of
9 the October 3, 1986 report of the zoning and subdivision examiner,
10 filed with the clerk of the council on October 30, 1986 and adopts
11 findings 1 through 5 and conclusion no. 2 of the said report.

12 The council further concludes that the existing area zoning was
13 applied to the subject property in error, and this reclassifica-
14 tion is required in the public interest. This ordinance
15 reclassifies the subject property from SR to RM-900-P, upon the
16 application of A & F Investments, designated building and land
17 development, department of planning and community development,
18 file no. 226-86-R, subject to the following conditions:

19 Pre-effective:

20 1. Dedicate to King County for public right-of-way the
21 south 20 feet of the subject property abutting So. 348th
22 Street as requested by the King County department of
23 public works. This condition shall be satisfied within
24 one year of council action on this application, or the
25 ordinance approving the application shall be of no further
26 force or effect.

27 Post-effective:

28 2. At the time of building permit review, the applicant
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shall demonstrate that this project will not aggravate existing or proposed drainage control systems in the area.
