ORDINANCE NO. 7908

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 86-3 to Southwest Suburban Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as 86-3 to Southwest Suburban Sewer District was filed with the county council effective September 30, 1986.

2. Southwest Suburban Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 86-45 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Southwest Suburban Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated August 8, 1986, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 12th day of January, 1987 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Southwest Suburban Sewer District of the area known as 86-3 and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 56.02.060 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on 86-3.

SECTION 2. The Southwest Suburban Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area, nor does it authorize sewer service in any area not designated as a "Local Service Area" by the King County Sewerage General Plan.

1 SECTION 4. The area known as 86-3 to be annexed is described
2 as follows:

3 That portion of the West 1/2 of Section 25, Township 23 North,
4 Range 3 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, described as
5 follows:

6 Beginning at the intersection of the centerlines of S.W. 170th
7 Street and 33rd Avenue S.W.;

8 Thence southerly along said centerline of 33rd Avenue S.W. to
9 the south margin of S.W. 171st Street extended easterly;

10 Thence westerly continuing along said extended margin and said
11 south margin to its intersection with the southerly extension
12 of th west line of Block 10, Gregory Heights, division No. 1,
13 as recorded in Volume 23 of Plats, page 44, Records of King
14 County, Washington;

15 Thence northerly continuing along existing District boundary
16 along said southerly extension, said west line and its
17 northerly extension to the centerline of Maplewild Avenue S.W.;

18 Thence northeasterly along said centerline to its intersection
19 with the northwesterly extension of the northeasterly line of
20 Lot 3, Block 8, said Plat of Gregory Heights, Division No. 1;

21 Thence southeasterly along said extended line, said
22 northeasterly line and said line extended southeasterly to the
23 easterly margin of S.W. 166th Street;

24 Thence westerly and southwesterly along said margin and the
25 southeasterly margin of Maplewild Avenue S.W. and its
26 southwesterly extension to the centerline of 33rd Avenue S.W.;

27 Thence southerly along said centerline to the Point of
28 Beginning.

29 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 22nd day
