AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to remand the application for unclassified use permit petitioned by WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY, designated Building and Land Development File No. 128-86-U.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the December 19, 1986 report of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on January 8, 1987 to remand to the building and land development division for preparation of a traffic study the application for unclassified use permit petitioned by Weyerhaeuser Company, designated building and land development file no. 128-86-U, and the council does hereby adopt as its action the recommendation contained in said report. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect.
