ORDINANCE NO. 7939

AN ORDINANCE approving the Federal Way Comprehensive Sewer Plan, Amendment Three.

PREAMBLE:

On February 4, 1986 the Board of Commissioners of the Federal Way Water and Sewer District passed Resolution 86-026 providing for addition and betterments to the Lakota Sewer Plant, amending the Comprehensive Sewer Plan, and adopting the Environmental Impact Statement for the Lakota Sewer Plant upgrade to secondary treatment.

On August 5, 1986, the Federal Way Water And Sewer District submitted Amendment Three of the Federal Way Sewer Comprehensive Plan for King County review.

On September 2, 1986, the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) met (pursuant to K.C.C. 13.24) and recommended approval of Amendment Three to the Federal Way Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Amendment Three of the Comprehensive Sewer Plan of the Federal Way Water and Sewer District, as adopted by Federal Way Water and Sewer District Resolution 86-026, is hereby approved.
