ORDINANCE NO. 7961

AN ORDINANCE approving the King County Water District 20 1986 Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On October 7, 1986, Water District 20 completed a Declaration of Non-significance to comply with the State Environmental Policy Act for their Water Plan.

On October 21, 1986, the Water District 20 Board of Commissioners passed Resolution 506 adopting their 1986 Comprehensive Water Plan.

On October 24, 1986, Water District 20 submitted their 1986 Comprehensive Water Plan to King County pursuant to K.C.C. 13.24.

On November 18, 1986, the Utilities Technical Review Committee met and recommended approval of the 1986 Water District 20 Comprehensive Water Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The 1986 Water District 20 Comprehensive Water Plan adopted by Water District 20 Resolution 506 is hereby approved.
