

ORDINANCE NO. 8027

AN ORDINANCE approving the King County Water District 107 Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On September 4, 1986, Water District 107 completed a Declaration of Non-significance to comply with the State Environmental Policy Act (for their water plan).

On January 14, 1987, the Water District 107 Board of Commissioners passed Resolution 959 adopting their 1986 Comprehensive Water Plan.

On February 2, 1987, Water District 107 submitted their 1986 Comprehensive Water Plan to King County pursuant to K.C.C. 13.24.

On February 17, 1987, the Utilities Technical Review Committee met and recommended approval of the 1986 Water District 107 Comprehensive Water Plan with a condition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The 1986 Water District 107 Comprehensive Water Plan adopted by Water District 107 Resolution 959 is hereby approved, with the following condition:

King County understands that Water District 107 will continue discussions with Bellevue and Renton on future service areas.
