AN ORDINANCE relating to councilmembers' compensation, amending Ordinance 6603 adding a new section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6603 is hereby amended by adding a new section as follows:

COUNCILMEMBERS' COMPENSATION. Consistent with Article XI, Section 8 of the Washington State Constitution, RCW 36.40.205, and Section 960 of the King County Charter; the compensation for all elective county council positions shall be increased at the rate of 3% per year effective January 1, 1990, and as of January 1st of each ensuing year.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6603, Sections 6 and 7 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The effective date of this ordinance shall be January 1, 1990.
