

Ordinance No. 18068

AN ORDINANCE authorizing a service fee for providing computer print-out pages of non-statutorily required reports.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to authorize departments of King County government to assess service fees for reimbursement of actual costs incurred by the county for the research, production and provision of computer print-out pages of requested reports which are not specifically required by statute to be provided.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall apply to the provision of non-statutorily required reports to any party other than a King County agency. The cost to any party other than a King County agent shall be the actual unit cost per print-out page or part thereof. This cost shall be based on data maintenance and input, research, and production time.

SECTION 3. Departments providing non-statutorily required reports shall establish a procedure for collection of these fees.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall not apply to infrequent provision of non-statutorily required reports if the collection of service fees is determined by a department to be cost ineffective.
