AN ORDINANCE approving the 1987 Federal Way Water and Sewer District Comprehensive Plan Amendment No. Four.

PREAMBLE:

On September 30, 1986, the Board of Commissioners of the Federal Way Water and Sewer District passed Resolution 86-071, amending the Comprehensive Sewerage Plan to revise service area boundaries and adopt additions and betterments to provide sewer treatment for areas whose sewage is currently treated by contract with the City of Tacoma.

On September 8, 1986, the Federal Way Water and Sewer District completed a Declaration of Non-significance for the Comprehensive Sewer Plan Amendment No. Four

On April 7, 1987, the Utilities Technical Review Committee met (pursuant to K.C.C 13.24) and recommended approval of Amendment No. Four to the Federal Way Water and Sewer District Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee approved said amendment with the understanding that service connections to the proposed facilities located outside the Local Service Area would not occur unless the Local Service Area was amended appropriately:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The 1987 Federal Way Water and Sewer District Comprehensive Sewer Plan Amendment No. Four is conditionally approved

Provided that:

The proposed facilities in said Amendment No. Four undergo sensitive areas review by King County.
