ORDINANCE NO. 8140

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$3,293,289 to the Automated Fingerprint Identification System Fund for the acquisition of an automated fingerprint identification computer system, funded from property tax revenues as approved by the King County voters and limited general obligation bond financing, amending Ordinance 7864, and adding a new section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$3,293,289 to the Automated Fingerprint Identification System Fund for the acquisition of an automated fingerprint identification computer system, funded from property tax revenues as approved by the King County voters, and limited general obligation bond financing.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. From the Automated Fingerprint System Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Automated Fingerprint Identification System \$3,293,289

PROVIDED THAT an automated fingerprint identification system maintenance agreement is finalized before or at the same time that the automated fingerprint identification system purchase agreement is finalized.
