ORDINANCE NO. 8211

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$236,049 to the Automated Fingerprint Identification System Fund for operating expenses, funded from property tax revenues as approved by the King County voters; and amending Ordinance 7864, Section 77, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$236,049 to the Automated Fingerprint Identification System Fund for expenditures associated with operating the AFIS computer system, funded by property tax revenues as approved by the King County voters.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 7864, Section 77, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
