AN ORDINANCE dissolving King County Road Improvement District No. 97

PREAMBLE:

The City of Bellevue, by its Ordinance 3585 and by validation of the voters has annexed an area encompassing King County Road Improvement District No. 97.

Road Improvement District No. 97 was created by King County Ordinance No. 6902 for the purposes of maintaining and providing energy for street lights within the plat of Wetherburn.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY.

Section 1. There is hereby dissolved, King County Road Improvement District No. 97 defined as the plat of Wetherburn as recorded in volume 96 of plats, page 16 and 17, records of King County, Washington.
