ORDINANCE NO. 8303

AN ORDINANCE changing the name of Empire Way also known as State Route 900 to Martin Luther King, Jr. Way pursuant to Resolution Number 264 of the Washington State Transportation Commission.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The portion of Empire Way also known as State Route 900 from the southerly city limits of Seattle to the westerly city limits of Renton shall be renamed Martin Luther King, Jr. Way pursuant to Resolution Number 264 of the Washington State Transportation Commission.

SECTION 2: The director of public works shall accomplish the necessary sign changes as early as practicable.
