ORDINANCE NO. 8307

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of RAGING RIVER MINING CO., INC., designated Building and Land Development File No. 122-86-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the October 16, 1987 report of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on November 5, 1987 on the application of Raging River Mining Co., Inc., to reclassify certain property described in building and land development file no. 122-86-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to reclassify the subject property from F-R, F-R (potential Q-M), and Q-M to Q-M-P for the 25.6 acre parcel adjacent to the south of the existing Q-M area, subject to conditions (modified) and deny reclassification of the 5.4 acres to the east (lot 4 of King County short plat no. 880098) and the 4.5 acres to the west (identified as having been acquired from Landon/Odyssey Development) is hereby adopted by the council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.)

1 Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building and land development  
2 division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this  
3 action.
