ORDINANCE NO. 8366

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of CAROLE PETERS, designated Building and Land Development File No. 220-87-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the December 2, 1987 revised report of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on December 17, 1987 on the application of Carole Peters to reclassify certain property described in building and land development file no. 220-87-R.

SECTION 2. The revised recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to reclassify the subject property from SR (potential RM-2400) and RS-7200 to RM-2400-P subject to conditions (modified) is hereby adopted by the council of King County. Those conditions which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied on or before December 31, 1989, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. The council may extend this date by motion pursuant to KCC 20.24.230. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building and land development division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
