ORDINANCE NO. 8388

AN ORDINANCE approving an Amendment to the Water District 127 Comprehensive Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On October 19, 1987, Water District 127 completed a Declaration of Non-significance to comply with the State Environmental Policy Act (for their comprehensive water plan amendment).

On October 19, 1987, the Board of Commissioners of Water District 127 passed Resolution 360 adopting their Comprehensive Plan Amendment

On October 30, 1987, Water District 127 submitted their Comprehensive Plan Amendment to King County pursuant to K.C.C. 13.24.

On November 17, 1987, the Utilities Technical Review Committee met and recommended approval of the Water District 127 Comprehensive Plan Amendment with a condition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 127 Comprehensive Plan Amendment adopted by the Board of Commissioners of Water District 127 is hereby approved, with the following condition:

A maximum of fifty (50) total service connections shall be permitted from this expanded water system. Proposals for more than fifty (50) service connections shall require Utility Technical Review Committee review and additional water storage capacity.
