AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of
an area known as Scheumann to Woodinville
Water District .

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Scheumann to Woodinville Water District was filed with the county council effective December 11, 1987.

2. Woodinville Water District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 2304 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Woodinville Water District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated November 5, 1987 on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 25th day of January, 1988 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Woodinville Water District of the area known as Scheumann and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Scheumann.

SECTION 2. Woodinville Water District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

1 SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute
2 county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifica-
3 tions, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation
4 area.

5 SECTION 4. The area known as Scheumann to be annexed is
6 described as follows:

7 That portion of the North half of section 26, Township 26
8 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian lying Easterly of
9 the Westerly margin of Woodinville-Redmond Road (Hwy. 202).

10 Expect the East half of the Northeast quarter of the
11 Northeast quarter of said Section 26.

12 Together with that portion of the North half of the
13 Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section
14 26, lying Westerly of said Highway 202.

15 Together with the Southwest quarter of the Northwest
16 quarter of Section 256, Township 26 North, Range 5 East,
17 Willamette Meridian.

18 Except that portion of the East half of the Southeast
19 quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter
20 of said Section 25 lying Southerly of N.E. 124th Street as
21 conveyed to King County by deeds recorded under King County
22 Recording Nos. 730517-0434 and 730517-0435.

23 All the above situated in King County, Washington.
