4 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Stadium Advisory  
5 Board, expanding the membership from five to  
6 nine members, and amending Ordinance 8034,  
Section 3.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 8034, Section 3, is hereby amended  
9 to read as follows: The stadium advisory board shall consist of  
10 ~~((five-(5)))~~ nine (9) members. Appointments and terms shall be as  
11 follows:

12 A. ~~((Three-(3)))~~ Five (5) members shall be appointed  
13 at-large by the King County executive. ~~((; subject to King County  
14 council confirmation; -- One of such members shall be appointed for  
15 a one-year term; one for a two-year term; and one for a three-year  
16 term; -- Thereafter, appointments shall be made for a three-year  
17 term))~~

18 B. ~~((Two-(2)))~~ Four (4) members shall be appointed by the  
19 King County executive from a list of candidates compiled by the  
20 King County council. ~~((Each King County council member shall  
21 submit to the King County executive one name from their district  
22 for appointment consideration; -- The King County executive will  
23 select two-(2) members from the combined list of candidates; -- One  
24 of such members shall be appointed for a one-year term and one for  
25 a two-year term; -- Thereafter, appointments shall be made for a  
26 three-year term;))~~

27 C. Appointments shall be for three year terms except  
28 original appointments which shall be staggered in accordance with  
29 K.C.C. 2.28. All appointments shall be subject to confirmation by  
30 a majority of the King County council. All terms shall expire on  
31 September 30th of the last year of the respective term.

1 ((G-)) D. Appointments shall be representative of the county  
2 population(s) and have interest, experience and a demonstrated  
3 commitment in the area of sporting and entertainment events.  
4 Appointment shall be made without regard to discrimination based  
5 on color, race, religion, gender, sexual preference and/or  
6 disability.

7 ((D-)) E. There shall be no fee required for membership, nor  
8 shall any member receive any financial remuneration for their  
9 services.

10 ((E-)) F. Members shall be eligible for reappointment to one  
11 additional term, for a period not to exceed a total of six years.

12 ((F-)) G. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment of the  
13 King County executive.
