ORDINANCE NO. 8488

AN ORDINANCE relating to the justice court of King County; stating the number of justices to be elected in each justice court district; providing for the number and name of each justice court district; setting the boundaries of each justice court district; amending Ordinance 3714, Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 24 as amended and K.C.C. 2.68.070 through K.C.C. 2.68.150, K.C.C. 2.68.170 through K.C.C. 2.68.200, and K.C.C. 2.68.230 through K.C.C. 2.68.250 and K.C.C. 2.68.260 and repealing Ordinance 3714, Sections 2, 10, 13, 14, 22, and 25 and K.C.C. 2.68.050; K.C.C. 2.68.060; K.C.C. 2.68.210; K.C.C. 2.68.220; K.C.C. 2.68.280; and K.C.C. 2.68.290.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 NEW SECTION. SECTION 3. Southwest district - Boundaries.
12 The legal boundaries of Southwest district court shall be:

13 BEGINNING at the intersection of the Puget Sound shoreline
14 and the extension of Qualheim Avenue Southwest (the southerly
15 corporate limits of the city of Seattle); thence northerly and
16 following said city limits to its intersection with the
17 centerline of 51st Avenue South; thence southerly following said
18 centerline to its intersection with the centerline of South
19 Juniper Street; thence east on said centerline to its
20 intersection with the centerline of Interstate 5; thence
21 southeasterly on said centerline to its intersection with the
22 north boundary of Tukwila corporate city limits; thence westerly
23 and following said corporate city limits to its intersection with
24 the centerline of Interstate 5; thence southerly on said
25 centerline to its intersection with the centerline of South 151st
26 Street; thence west on said centerline to its intersection with
27 the west boundary of Tukwila corporate city limits; thence south
28 and following said corporate city limits to its intersection with
29 the centerline of Military Road South; thence southerly on said
