ORDINANCE NO. 8517

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Tukwila
1984 Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On February 7, 1983, the City of Tukwila completed a Declaration of Non-significance to comply with the State Environmental Policy Act (for their sewer plan).

On March 5, 1984, the City of Tukwila Council passed Resolution 904 adopting their 1984 Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

On December 22, 1987, the City of Tukwila submitted their 1984 Comprehensive Sewer Plan to King County pursuant to K.C.C. 13.24.

On January 19, 1988, the Utilities Technical Review Committee met and recommended approval of the City of Tukwila 1984 Comprehensive Sewer Plan with a condition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Tukwila 1984 Comprehensive Sewer Plan adopted by the City of Tukwila Resolution 904 is hereby approved, with the following condition:

The City of Tukwila Comprehensive Sewer Plan shall be submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee for review and King County Council action within twelve (12) months of the Tukwila City Council's approval of their updated sewer plan. This plan shall include reference to King County plans and policies (King County Code, Chapter 13.24, Sewer and Water Comprehensive Plans) and expanded sewer service planning and study areas.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 2nd day of May, 1988.
