ORDINANCE NO. 8532

AN ORDINANCE establishing the Skyway
Coordinated Water Supply Plan Boundaries,
repealing Ordinance 7892.

PREAMBLE:

RCW 70.116.040 requires that the Skyway Water Utility
Coordinating Committee establish the boundaries of the
coordinated water supply area.

On July 3, 1986, the Skyway Water Utility Coordinating
Committee (established through Ordinance 7587 on May 18, 1986)
discussed the boundaries of the Skyway Coordinated Water
Supply area.

On September 4, 1986 (in public hearing), the Committee
approved the boundary and requested that the King County
council formally establish the boundary.

On April 21, 1988 (in public hearing), the Committee approved
amending the boundary to include Creston Water Association in
the northwest corner of the area.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 7892 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The Skyway Coordinated Water Supply Plan Boundary,
as approved by the Skyway Water Utility Coordinating Committee, is
hereby established as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the current City of
Renton's western boundary and Lake Washington; thence
south along the present Renton city limits line to Rainier
Avenue; thence south along the east side of Rainier Avenue
to the intersection with Sunset Boulevard West; thence
following the south side of Sunset Boulevard west westerly
to the present Renton city limits line; thence following
the present Renton city limits line west to its
intersection with the railroad; thence following the south
side of the railroad in a southwesterly direction to its
intersection with 68th Avenue South; thence in a westerly
direction to the intersection of the west bank of the
Duwamish River and the south right-of-way of South 143rd
Street; thence following the west and south river bank of
the Duwamish River in a northwesterly direction to its
intersection with 56th Avenue South; thence southwesterly
along 56th Avenue South to the southerly right-of-way of
Interurban Avenue South; thence southeasterly along the
south side of Interurban Avenue South to South 137th
Street which is the present Tukwila city limits;

1 Thence following the present Tukwila city limits line for
2 the next eight courses; thence west along South 137th
3 Street to 51st Avenue South; thence south along 51st
4 Avenue South to South 139th Street; thence east along
5 South 139th Street to 53rd Avenue South; thence north
6 along 53rd Avenue South; thence easterly along the present
7 Tukwila city limits; thence southeasterly along the
8 Tukwila city limits line to it's intersection with South
9 139th Street; thence west along South 139th Street to 53rd
10 Avenue South; thence south along 53rd Avenue South to it's
11 intersection with the easterly right-of-way of I-5 and the
12 north end of Macadam Road; thence west across I-5 to the
13 westerly right-of-way of I-5; thence north following the
14 westerly right of way of I-5 to it's intersection with the
15 southerly right-of-way of Highway 599; thence north and
16 west following the westerly and southerly right-of-way of
17 Highway 599 to it's intersection with East Marginal Way
18 South;

11 Thence following the westerly right-of-way of East
12 Marginal Way South to South 112th Street; thence east
13 along the northerly right-of-way of South 112th Street (if
14 extended) to the westerly right-of-way of I-5; thence
15 northwest along the westerly right-of-way of I-5 to South
16 107th Street (if extended); thence easterly along the
17 extension of South 107th Street to its intersection with
18 the current City of Seattle 316/450 pressure zone
19 boundary; thence northwesterly following the current City
20 of Seattle 316/450 pressure zone boundary through a loop
21 around Beacon Avenue South, west in the vicinity of South
22 Norfolk Street, north in the area of 59th Avenue South to
23 Waters Avenue South where the pressure zone line turns
24 southeast and follows Waters Avenue South to it's
25 intersection with South Ryan Street; thence easterly
26 following the north right-of-way of South Ryan Street (if
27 extended) to the southeasterly shore of Lake Washington;
28 thence southeasterly along the mean low water line of Lake
29 Washington to the point of beginning.

21 A map of the boundaries is attached to and hereby made a part
22 of this ordinance.
