ORDINANCE NO. 8585

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$170,000 to the Solid Waste Fund for recycling demonstration projects and grants to cities; amending Ordinance No. 8331, Section 69, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$170,000 to the Solid Waste Fund from unencumbered fund balance for the purpose of establishing a formal recycling demonstration program serving unincorporated county areas and for matching grants to cities for recycling program planning. Funds shall be used to contract with independent recyclers and franchised waste haulers for curbside recycling, drop-off recycling sites, apartment recycling programs, matching grants to cities and to provide for administrative costs by the solid waste division.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 8331, Section 69, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting the following:

SOLID WASTE - From the Solid Waste Fund additional funds are hereby appropriated to:

PROVIDED THAT:

These funds shall not be used to duplicate recycling program costs provided within the rate base of any franchised hauler,

5 Committee.
