8619 ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date of an election on the question of annexation to the City of Redmond of an area known as Matthews.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT:

- The City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, by Resolution No. 765 has resolved that the best interest, and general welfare of the City of Redmond would be served by the annexation of contiguous unincorporated territory known as Matthews, legally described in Section 2 of this ordinance.
- 2. Said resolution does satisfy the provisions of Chapter 35A.14 R.C.W. for qualification for annexation by election.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 8th day of November, 1988, in accordance with R.C.W. 35.13.070 within the territory of the proposed annexation as herein described, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors within said territory, the question of annexation to the City of Redmond.

SECTION 2. The boundaries of the territory proposed for annexation are hereby described as follows:

That portion of the east one half of Section 1, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington.
