ORDINANCE NO. 8628

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$1,141,280 to the Solid Waste Fund for waste reduction and recycling (WR/R) projects; amending Ordinance No. 8331, Section 69, as amended.

PREAMBLE:

Waste reduction and recycling have been identified as the top two solid waste management priorities by both King County and the state of Washington and will be an integral part of any solid waste management strategy that is selected by the county. There is a need to increase funding for waste reduction and recycling programs now to ensure full implementation in 1989.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$1,141,280 to the Solid Waste Fund from unencumbered fund balance for the purpose of establishing various waste reduction/recycling (WR/R) projects. Funds shall be used to create or expand projects provided by the solid waste division or through service contracts and shall pay for programs in yard waste composting; collection, processing and market development; education, promotion and public involvement; waste reduction, and to provide for administrative costs.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 8331, Section 69, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting the following:

SOLID WASTE - From the Solid Waste Fund additional funds are hereby appropriated to:

1 PROVIDED that when the executive proposed 1989 budget is
2 submitted to the council it shall include a recommendation and
3 funding for expansion of technical assistance to commercial and
4 institutional waste generators.

5 PROVIDED FURTHER THAT no funds shall be spent for the
6 backyard composting program or transfer station recycling program
7 until an environmental checklist as required under SEPA has been
8 completed on each project, respectively.
