ORDINANCE NO. **8682**

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$1,586,442 to public health pooling, King County division and public health pooling, Seattle division, and the division of alcoholism and substance abuse from state and federal funds, contract fees, vital statistics fees, sale of surplus property and public health pooling fund balance; amending Ordinance No. 8331, Sections 62 and 64, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$1,586,442 to public health pooling, King County divisions, and public health pooling, Seattle division and the division of alcoholism and substance abuse from state and federal funds, contract fees, vital statistic fees, sale of surplus property and public health pooling fund balance.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 8331, Section 62 as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

Public Health Pooling - King County Division \$1,444,895

The maximum number of FTE's for Public Health Pooling - King County Division shall be:

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 8331, Section 62 as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PUBLIC HEALTH POOLING - SEATTLE DIVISION - From the Public Health Pooling Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Public Health Pooling - Seattle Division \$ 78,547
