ORDINANCE NO. 8715

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of
an area known as Hammer to King County
Water District No. 119.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Hammer to King County Water District No. 119 was filed with the county council effective October 6, 1988.

2. King County Water District No. 119 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 202 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 119 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated July 22, 1988, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 31st day of October, 1988 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 119 of the area known as Hammer and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Hammer.

SECTION 2. King County Water District No. 119 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

1 SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute
2 county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifica-
3 tions, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation
4 area.

5 SECTION 4. The area known as Hammer to be annexed is
6 described as follows:

7 Those parcels of land lying within Sections 16, 17 and 20,
8 Township 26 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian in
9 King County, Washington more particularly described as follows:

10 The south half of the southwest quarter of Section 16,
11 Township 26 North, Range 7 East; and the northeast quarter of
12 the southeast quarter and the south half of the southeast
13 quarter of Section 17, Township 26 North, Range 7 East of the
14 Willamette Meridian and also the northeast quarter of Section
15 20, Township 26 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian
16 in King County, Washington.
