ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to paid parking in county owned parking facilities, establishing fees and amending Ordinance No. 3511, Sections 4 and 5, and K.C.C. 3.32.030 and 3.32.040; repealing Ordinance No. 6599, Section 1 and K.C.C 3.32.020 and substituting a new section; and adding new sections.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6599, Section 1, as amended and K.C.C. 3.32.020 are hereby repealed and the following substituted:

Parking Fees - General. A. All county employees and elected officials who are assigned the regular use of a parking stall within any of the county-owned parking facilities shall pay parking fees as provided in this chapter. Parking fees shall not be paid by the county in behalf of any individual employee or elected official who is assigned the regular use of a county parking stall regardless of whose vehicle that person parks in Current county employees covered by existing the stall. collective bargaining agreements shall be affected only in a manner consistent with state law.

- Method of payment. Such parking fees shall be paid through monthly payroll deductions from the wages of the employee or elected official who is assigned the regular use of the county parking stall regardless of whether that person is assigned the use of a county owned vehicle, assigned a vehicle provided at county expense, or uses a privately-owned vehicle.
- Optional survey. The department of executive administration may conduct a survey of the monthly parking rates charged for public parking in lots of ten or more spaces within the area bounded by Jackson Street on the south, Sixth Avenue on the east, Columbia Street on the north and Second Avenue on the

west. Such survey and any parking fee recommendations shall be forwarded to the council for consideration during the budget process.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3511, Section 4, and K.C.C. 3.32.030 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Exemptions. King County motor pool vehicles not assigned to individuals are exempt from the provisions of Section 3.32.020 ((provided-that-this-exemption-shall-expire-December-31,-1978, and-the-the-implementing-plan-to-charge-motor-pool-vehicles-will be-presented-to-the-council-by-July-1,-1978)).

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 3511, Section 5 and K.C.C. 3.32.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Public parking area. Parking spaces will be established for public parking without charge to be used in connection with county business. ((Publie)) Said parking shall be limited to two hours. Exceptions can be made if they meet explicit criteria for exemptions established ((by-the-King-Gounty administrative-officer)) in accordance with Section 3.32.010 and monitored by the King County auditor.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 4. County automotive parking facilities shall refer to the parking spaces found in the following areas:

- A. County automotive center, 5th and Jefferson.
- B. County courthouse, 3rd and James.
- C. County adult detention center, 5th and James.
- D. Open surface lots located at 5th and Jefferson, and on Yesler.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 5. Parking Rates - Parking stalls in the King County automotive center, adult detention center and courthouse. The basic monthly parking rate for parking stalls in the county automotive center, adult detention center and courthouse shall be as follows:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 6. Parking Rates - Surface Parking Lots. The parking rates for daily parking in designated open surface parking lots shall be as follows:

A. General parking on county business which exceeds the two hour limit, general public not on county business, and county employees:

1. Effective January 1, 1989:

0- 2 hours \$3.00 2- 4 hours \$5.00 4-10 hours \$7.00 Special events \$6.00

- 2. Evenings after 6 p.m. and all day
 Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays
 except during special events. \$4.00
- B. Special events rates conditions. Special events rates shall apply after 6 pm weekdays and all day Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays and shall apply during those events designated in accordance with Section 3.32.010. These rates shall not apply to county employees using county parking stalls while engaged in county business.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 7. Parking Fee Revenues Disposition. All revenues derived from parking fee rates shall
be used to pay the operating expenses of county parking
facilities and the bond retirement for the automotive center.

PROVIDED THAT:

All parking revenues derived from the increase of parking rates effective on or after January 1, 1989 shall be reserved for the support of health and human services activites and shall be deposited in the Health and Human Services Set-aside Fund.
