

ORDINANCE NO. 9009

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 8974 and concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of HENRY SURBECK, designated Building and Land Development File No. 200-89-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance no. 8974 is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the February 17, 1989 report and the March 31, 1989 proposed order of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on June 1, 1989, on the application of Henry Surbeck to reclassify certain property described in building and land development file no. 200-89-R.

SECTION 3. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to reclassify the subject property from RS 7200 to RM 900-P subject to conditions is hereby adopted by the council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building and land development division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
