3 ORDINANCE NO. 9084

4 AN ORDINANCE relating to zoning; revising the
5 permitted use provisions of the
6 Forest-Recreation (F-R) zone classification;
7 repealing Ordinance 8903, Section 1 and
8 K.C.C. 21.38.020; and adding a new section to
9 K.C.C. 21.38.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 SECTION 1. Ordinance 8903, Section 1, and K.C.C. 21.38.020
12 are each repealed.

13 NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is added to K.C.C. 21.38 a
14 new section to read as follows:

15 Permitted uses. In an F-R zone, the following uses only are
16 permitted and as hereinafter specifically provided and allowed by
17 this chapter:

18 A. The growing and harvesting of forest products, the
19 operation of sawmills, log storage yards, and activities and
20 structures incidental to each;

21 B. Livestock grazing and agricultural buildings and
22 structures incidental thereto, and beehives, as provided in
23 Section 21.22.020;

24 C. Unclassified uses as provided in Chapter 21.44;

25 D. Game and fish management;

26 E. Dams, power plants, flowage areas, transmission lines and
27 stations, together with necessary accessory building;

28 F. Harvesting of any wild crop such as marsh hay, ferns, moss
29 and berries;

30 G. Single-family residence, trailer, private summer cottages
31 and incidental service buildings; provided, that multiple-lot
32 subdivisions of more than four lots shall require a planned unit
33 development to assure environmental protection;

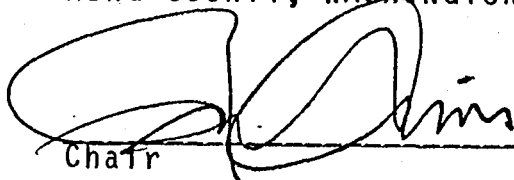

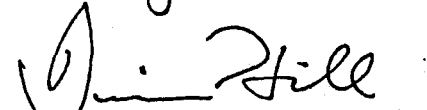
