ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance 9145 and thereby cancelling a special election for the purpose of submitting to the voters of King County on November 7, 1989 a proposition authorizing the sale or exchange of certain real property owned by King County and purchased with the proceeds of the Harbor Bonds passed by the voters in 1910; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Repeal of Ordinance 9145 and cancellation of Special Election. Ordinance 9145 calling for a special election for the purpose of submitting to the voters of King County on November 7, 1989 a proposition authorizing the sale or exchange of certain real property owned by King County and purchased with the proceeds of the Harbor Bonds passed by the voters in 1910, and declaring an emergency, is hereby repealed, and the special election called for by that ordinance is thereby cancelled.

The Clerk of the Council is authorized and directed to immediately certify and transmit this ordinance to the manager of the King County Record and Elections Division.

The manager of the King County Records and Elections Division, as ex officio supervisor of all elections held within King County, is requested to cancel the special election called for in Ordinance 9145 and to withdraw the proposition presented in that ordinance from the ballot.

SECTION 2. Emergency. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health




