ORDINANCE NO. **9156**

AN ORDINANCE relating to property tax
refunds, amending Ordinance No. 1809
and K.C.C. 4.64.010.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1809, Section 1 and K.C.C. 4.64.010 are
hereby amended to read as follows:

Shortened refund application form availability and use. The
~~((director,-office-of-finance))~~ assessor shall make available to
taxpayers who are entitled to a tax refund by a final order of
the Board of Equalization, as provided by R.C.W. 84.69.020(9), or
by a final order of the State Board of Tax Appeals, as provided
by R.C.W. 84.69.020 ~~((9))~~ (10) a shortened refund application
form consistent with the provisions of ~~((R.C.W.))~~ Chapter 84.69
R.C.W. Such form shall include only such information necessary
to establish the validity and finality of the action taken by the
Board of Equalization or the Board of Tax Appeals. When such
form, together with the decision of ~~((the))~~ a ~~((b))~~ Board, has
been filed with and verified by the ~~((clerk-of-the-council-and
served-on-the-King-County))~~ assessor, the ~~((director,-office-of))~~
finance division manager shall make the appropriate refund
determined by the Board of Equalization or the Board of Tax
Appeals together with interest as prescribed by law without
regard to the limitation contained in R.C.W. 84.69.030(2) and
without council action; provided, that no refunds shall be made
under this shortened procedure where the taxpayer fails to make
application for refund hereunder within three months of the date
of receiving the final decision of ~~((the))~~ a Board ~~((of-Tax
Appeals))~~; or where the assessor has given timely notice of
appeal from the decision of ~~((the))~~ a Board ~~((of-Tax-Appeals))~~;


1 provided further, that no provision of this section shall affect
2 any other procedures or forms relating to ((R.C.W.)) Chapter
3 84.69 R.C.W. refunds.

4 SECTION 2. The Board of Equalization and the State Board of
5 Tax Appeals shall, by the first Monday in January of each year,
6 provide a written list to the Finance Committee of all appeals
7 pending longer than three years.
