ORDINANCE NO. **9208**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive to apply for, receive, and disburse funds from the Washington State Department of Ecology for sewer facility plans for the communities of Carnation, Fall City, and Skykomish; and to enter into agreements necessary to effect sewer facility plans for each community; and appropriating \$174,000 to the Grant Fund for the project, and amending Ordinance No. 8802, Section 73, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Definitions. Unless the context otherwise requires, the terms defined in this section shall, for all purposes of this ordinance and any ordinance supplemental hereto, have meanings as follows:

"County" means King County, Washington.

"Council" means the county council of King County, Washington.

"DOE" means the Washington State Department of Ecology.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that environmental and public health hazards exist in the communities of Carnation, Fall City, and Skykomish due to failing individual wastewater septic systems.

SECTION 3. It is further found and determined that a sewer facility plan is required for communities seeking state or federal funding for sewer design and construction.

SECTION 4. It is further found and determined that a combined project, managed by the county, which results in one sewer facility plan for each of the three communities is in the best interests of the county and the affected communities.

1        SECTION 5. It is further found and determined that the  
 2 entire cost of preparing three approvable sewer facility plans  
 3 will require up to \$348,850 in consulting engineering services,  
 4 county staff time, community staff time, and related  
 5 miscellaneous expenses.

6        SECTION 6. It is further found and determined that the King  
 7 County council has already appropriated \$72,000 in 1989 King  
 8 County Community Development Block Grant funds, which together  
 9 with \$102,850 in county staff time, community staff time, and  
 10 related miscellaneous in-kind resources represents \$174,850,  
 11 fifty percent of the project's \$348,000 cost.

12        SECTION 7. It is further found and determined that the DOE  
 13 has agreed that \$174,000 of Interim Centennial Clean Water Fund -  
 14 Referendum 39 grant money is available to the county for the  
 15 preparation of sewer facility plans.

16        SECTION 8. The King County executive is authorized to apply  
 17 for, receive, and disburse funds from DOE for sewer facility  
 18 plans for the City of Carnation, the City of Skykomish, and the  
 19 community of Fall City; and to enter into agreements necessary to  
 20 effect sewer facility plans for each community.

21        SECTION 9. Ordinance No. 8802, Section 73, is hereby amended  
 22 by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

23        GRANTS FUND - From the Grants Fund - Operating there is  
 24 hereby appropriated to:


26        SECTION 10. Should any section, subsection, paragraph,


