AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$61,579 to the Involuntary Treatment Fund from additional revenue from the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services for Involuntary Treatment Act Administration; and amending Ordinance No. 8802, Section 64, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$61,579 from additional revenue from Washington State Department of Social and Health Services to supplement the 1989-91 biennium funding for Involuntary Treatment Act Administration.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 8802, Section 64, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:




