AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Harborview Medical Center to immediately install an environmental chamber in its pulmonary function laboratory suite with funds appropriated for that purpose, notwithstanding any ordinance provisions to the contrary.

PREAMBLE:

Funds to permit the Harborview Medical Center to purchase and install an environmental chamber in its pulmonary function laboratory suite have been appropriated. All necessary approvals from the State Department of Social and Health Services have been secured, and the immediate installation of the chamber is necessary to ensure the safety of patients undergoing, and staff conducting, exposure challenge testing at Harborview. Such installation and related work should proceed immediately, notwithstanding any ordinance provisions that might otherwise apply, including those related to capital improvements at Harborview, bidding procedures for public contracts, and the participation of minority and women's business enterprises.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Harborview Medical Center is authorized to proceed immediately with the installation of an environmental chamber within its pulmonary function laboratory suite, as described in the program plan and budget attached to this ordinance, using funds appropriated for that purpose, notwithstanding the provisions of any ordinance to the contrary.


