ORDINANCE NO. **9399**

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation of the City of Issaquah into the King County Rural Library District and declaring an emergency.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The City of Issaquah, Washington by Ordinance No. 1846, has initiated the proposed annexation and expressed its intent to join the King County Rural Library District, finding that the public interest will be served thereby. The Issaquah Library Board recommended annexation as specified in RCW 27.12.360.

City of Issaquah Ordinance No. 1846 does satisfy the provisions of RCW 27.12.010 (5), and 27.12.360 requesting the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein.

The Board of Trustees of the King County Rural Library District by Resolution No. 1990-4 has concurred with the proposal as submitted on March 20, 1990, all in accordance with RCW 27.12.360.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 22nd day of May, 1990 within the City of Issaquah. The ballot proposition shall be in substantially the following form in accordance with RCW 27.12.370:

"Shall the City of Issaquah, Washington be annexed to and be part of the King County Rural Library District?"

SECTION 2. Notice of election shall be published as required by law.
