AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of E. C. Griswold County Road No.855 Petitioners: Kenneth Hunter and Others V-1850

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of E.C. Griswold County Road, hereinafter described.
- 2. The division of building and land development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 4. The King County Interim Transportation Plan designates 212th Way S.E. as a secondary arterial adjacent to the applicant's property and as such will require 42 feet of right-of-way east and west of the centerline in the future. At the present time King County has only 30 feet of right-of-way on each side of the centerline. The department of public works recommends that the applicant dedicate the additional right-of-way which will be needed for that roadway in exchange for the property which he has requested King County to vacate. King County is now in receipt of a Warranty Deed from Kenneth C. Hunter for the requested right-of-way.
- 5. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way outside of the 84-foot corridor useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls. The vacation area is classified "B Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759. King County is now in receipt of a check in the amount of \$1,931.79 from the petitioner. The vacation area consists of 50,000 square feet. Using the assessed value of the adjoining lands, the compensation for the vacation is calculated at \$4,877.54. The value of the property to be deeded to King County is \$2,945.75 (25,950 sq. ft.) leaving a net amount of \$1,931.79.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the \_\_\_\_\_day of 19 .

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
