

ORDINANCE NO. **9531**

AN ORDINANCE making supplemental appropriations of \$300,000 to the department of adult detention from special programs, executive contingency for the preparation of a phased-review environmental impact statement, and \$25,000 to special programs and \$17,018 to superior court from Special Programs, Executive Contingency to participate in the planning for potential new permanent jail capacity; and amending Ordinance No. 9221, Sections 30, 36, 37 and 51, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$300,000 to the department of adult detention from special programs, executive contingency for the preparation of a phased-review environmental impact statement, and \$25,000 to special programs and \$17,018 to superior courts from special programs, executive contingency to participate in the planning for potential new permanent jail capacity.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 30, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SUPERIOR COURT - From Special Programs, Executive Contingency, there is hereby appropriated to:

Superior Court \$17,018

SECTION 3. Ordinance 9221, Section 36, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS - From Special Programs, Executive Contingency, there is hereby appropriated to:

Special Programs \$25,000

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 37, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS, EXECUTIVE CONTINGENCY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby disappropriated from:

Special Programs, Executive Contingency (\$342,018)

SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 51, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

1 ADULT DETENTION - From Special Programs, Executive Contingency, there is
2 hereby appropriated to:

3 Adult Detention \$300,000

4 SECTION 6. Certain costs, included in Sections 2, 3 and 5, which are
5 related to the activation of additional jail space, are intended to be reim-
6 bursed from future bond proceeds.

7 SECTION 7. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emer-
8 gency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preserva-
9 tion of public peace, health or safety or the support of county government
10 and its existing public institution.
