

ORDINANCE NO. **9538**

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2 AN ORDINANCE relating to 1% for Art; amending Ordinance 6111,
3 Sections 4, 5, and 8, as amended; Ordinance 9134, Sections 8
4 and 13; K.C.C. 4.04.040; 4.04.070; 4.04.090; 4.04.110; and
4.04.120;

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. Ordinance 6111 Section 4, as amended, and KCC 4.40.040, as
7 amended, are hereby amended to read as follows:

8 Appropriations. All future appropriations for county construction
9 projects shall include an amount to be set aside for transfer to the 1% for
10 Art Fund, except for appropriations for roads, bridges, sewers, surface water
11 projects, solid waste landfills, and maintenance projects, and except for
12 supplemental appropriations to correct actual or anticipated project overruns
13 not involving a change in project scope. The transfer appropriations from the
14 various projects shall be pooled in the 1% for Art fund ((-)) except that when
15 bond proceeds are involved the 1% for Arts project may be retained in the
16 respective bond fund if necessary to comply with financial accounting
17 requirements and bond conditions.

18 SECTION 2. Ordinance 9134 Section 8 and K.C.C. 4.040.070 are hereby
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Annual 1% for Art projects plan. Beginning with the 1990 budget review
21 and adoption process and each year thereafter the Arts Commission shall
22 prepare and recommend to the executive and the council a 1% for Art projects
23 plan which identifies and describes projects to be ((~~accomplished~~)) initiated
24 during the coming budget year from the 1% for Art Fund. It is recognized that
25 the accuracy of this plan is contingent upon the availability and
26 interdepartmental evaluation of the Capital Improvement Program request and
27 therefore may require update and amendment by the county council upon its
28 review. The annual 1% for Art projects plan may include a special projects
29 category to allow for flexibility and responsiveness. This plan shall be
30 approved by the council as the basis for the 1% for Art Fund appropriation.
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1 SECTION 3. Ordinance 6111, Section 5, as amended, and KCC. 4.40.090, as
2 amended, are hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Transfer to 1% for Art Fund" projects. The funds appropriated pursuant
4 to this section shall be appropriated for transfer to the 1% for Art fund.
5 Upon the effective date of such appropriations, funds shall be transferred by
6 the county executive or his representative to the project designated as the
7 "Transfer to 1% for Art Fund" and shall then be automatically transferred to
8 the 1% for Art Fund (~~(-)~~) except that when bond proceeds are involved the 1%
9 for Art moneys may be retained in the respective bond funds if necessary to
10 comply with financial accounting requirements and bond conditions.

11 Expenditures from the 1% for Art Fund shall be separately appropriated by the
12 council based upon the 1% for Art projects plan submitted from the Arts
13 Commission through the executive.

14 SECTION 4. Ordinance 6111 Section 8, as amended, and K.C.C. 4.40.110, as
15 amended, are hereby amended to read as follows:

16 General Obligation Bond proceeds. In the case of any county construction
17 project which involves the use of General Obligation Bond proceeds, amounts
18 for works of art described in this chapter shall be used for projects and
19 capital purposes consistent with the resolution(s) or ordinance(s) approved by
20 the voters or the county council. Bond (~~(funds)~~) proceeds shall be accounted
21 for within the respective bond funds or separately within the 1% for Art Fund
22 ((if)) whichever is necessary to comply with these requirements.

23 SECTION 5. Ordinance 9134, Section 13, and K.C.C. 4.40.120 are hereby
24 amended to read as follows:

25 Harborview Medical Center capital reserves. For any 1% for Art funds
26 which involve the use of Harborview Medical Center's capital reserves (Fund
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1 396), amounts for works of art described in this chapter shall be used for art
2 projects at Harborview Medical Center. These funds may be accounted for
3 within Fund 396 or separately within the 1% for Art Fund if necessary to
4 comply with this requirement.
