

ORDINANCE NO. **9713**

AN ORDINANCE relating to fees charged for the use of King County parks and recreation facilities and amending Ordinance No. 9595, Sections 1 and 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 7.08.020 and 7.08.25; and Ordinance 9227, Sections 2 and 3, as amended, and K.C.C. 7.08.030 and 7.08.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 9525, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C. 7.08.020 are amended to read as follows:

I. Effective June 1, 1991, swimming pool facilities (except Weyerhaeuser King County Aquatics Center). Swimming pool facilities fees shall be:

A. Swimming pool fees (fees include sales tax)

- Public Swims:.....(~~(\$1.20)~~) \$1.25 per person per session
- (~~(Sixty)~~) Seventy-five Cent Swims: ..(~~(.60)~~) .75 per person per session
- Adult Only Swims: .....(~~(1.80)~~) 1.90 per person per session
- Senior citizens-60 years plus.....(~~(1.20)~~) 1.25 per person for any

program session.

B. Swim lessons: \$1.00 per half hour to \$10.00 per half hour

C. Pool rentals

15 documented proof of disability to qualify for reduced fees.

13 softball, basketball, soccer, volleyball, racquetball, etc.)

17 A ten percent administrative surcharge not to exceed \$5.00 will be  
18 assessed per participant per registration on the class or event cost for  
19 all fee structured classes special events, athletic fee programs,  
20 workshops, special events or seminars. This administrative costs will not  
21 be charged for regularly scheduled programs or events which are intended  
22 solely for the enjoyment of citizens 55 years or older.

- 20           such as community clubs, Orthopedic Guilds, service clubs, and public
- 21           meetings. If the activity under sponsorship is open to the public
- 22           and conforms to the rules of the activity center and is scheduled
- 23           during the activity center program hours, there is no charge.
- 24           2. Activity Centers and Community Centers
- 25           (For any organizations, groups and clubs, using an activity or commu-
- 26           nity center during nonprogram hours, or a community center at any
- 27           time during the day or evening, the following fee schedule will be
- 28           applied.)
- 29           Gymnasium . . . . . \$20.00 per hour (2 hour minimum)
- 30           Meeting room fee . . . . . \$15.00 per hour (2 hour minimum)
- 31           3. Kitchen Use Fee (All facilities except Clise Mansion)
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(Facility users will not be assessed a kitchen fee to obtain water for coffee pots).

Kitchen use fees . . . . . \$ 5.00 per hour (2 hour minimum)

4. Creek Lodge Use Fee (Rate includes use of Kitchen)

Meeting Room . . . . . \$15.00 per hour (2 hour minimum)

Overnight Rate:

Youth Groups . . . . . \$75.00 per night

Adult Groups . . . . . \$150.00 per night

5. Clise Mansion Use Fees

a. Rental of entire mansion except kitchen and museum

Wednesday - Sunday, March - October \$200/2-6 hours inclusive

Wednesday - Sunday, November - February \$35/hour, 2 hour minimum

Monday and Tuesday, year round . . . . \$30/hour, 2 hour minimum

b. Rental of individual meeting rooms (Mondays and Tuesdays only)

Monday and Tuesday, year round . . . . . \$10/hour, 2 hour minimum

c. Rental of commercial kitchen

Wednesday - Sunday, Year Round . . . . . \$50 flat fee

Monday - Tuesday, Year Round . . . . . \$10/hour, 2 hour minimum

(Facility users will not be assessed a kitchen fee to obtain water for coffee pots).

6. Outdoor Facility Use Fee

(Any groups renting outdoor facilities for activities including, but not limited to, dog shows, outdoor weddings, day camps, Fun Runs and organized picnics will pay according to the following fee schedule.)

1-100 participants . . . . . \$30.00 per day

101+ participants . . . . . \$ 0.30 per participant per day

7. Reservation Form Handling Fee

All groups will be assessed a \$5.00 handling fee per Reservation Form.

8. Admission and/or Concession Fees - . . . . . 20% of gross revenue

(will assess 20% to gross revenue collected by renter from

admission/participant fees and/or sales of goods and/or services.

9. Special Facility Use Fee

Luther Burbank Amphitheater .... \$20.00 per hour, 2 hour minimum

Raquetball Courts - White Center Park . . \$6.00 per hour

10. Camping Fee . . . \$7.00 per site (includes tax) includes one vehicle,  
each additional vehicle \$3.00 unless vehicle towed with R.V.

11. Public Event Parking Fee .. \$3.00 per car (includes tax)

12. Pea Patch rental . . . . \$25.00 per plot per season

Two plots . . . . . \$40.00 per person per season

13. (~~Total~~) Detector Permits . . \$10.00 per year per individual \$15.00  
per year per family (4 maximum)

14. Special Use Permits

Groups renting facilities for special event activities shall pay fees  
determined through negotiated contract.

15. Power Fees, Damage and Key Deposits

For any organizations, groups, or clubs using an activity center or  
community center, power fees and a damage and key deposit fee may be  
assessed according to the following schedule.

Power Fees . . . . . \$25.00 per day

Damage deposit . . . . . \$25.00 to \$200.00

(determined by type of activity and number of participants)

Key deposit . . . . . \$25.00 to \$50.00

(determined by type of activity and number of participants)

16. Overnight Boat

Moorage fees . . . . . \$6.00 per night

(~~including tax~~) For boats 26 feet in length |

and over \$4.00 per night (~~including tax~~)

For boats under 26 feet in length.

D. The effective date of K.C.C. 7.08.040 F.1 establishing "no charge" to civic or nonprofit organizations for the use of activity centers shall be April 5, 1982; the date Ordinance 5935 was adopted by the council.
